



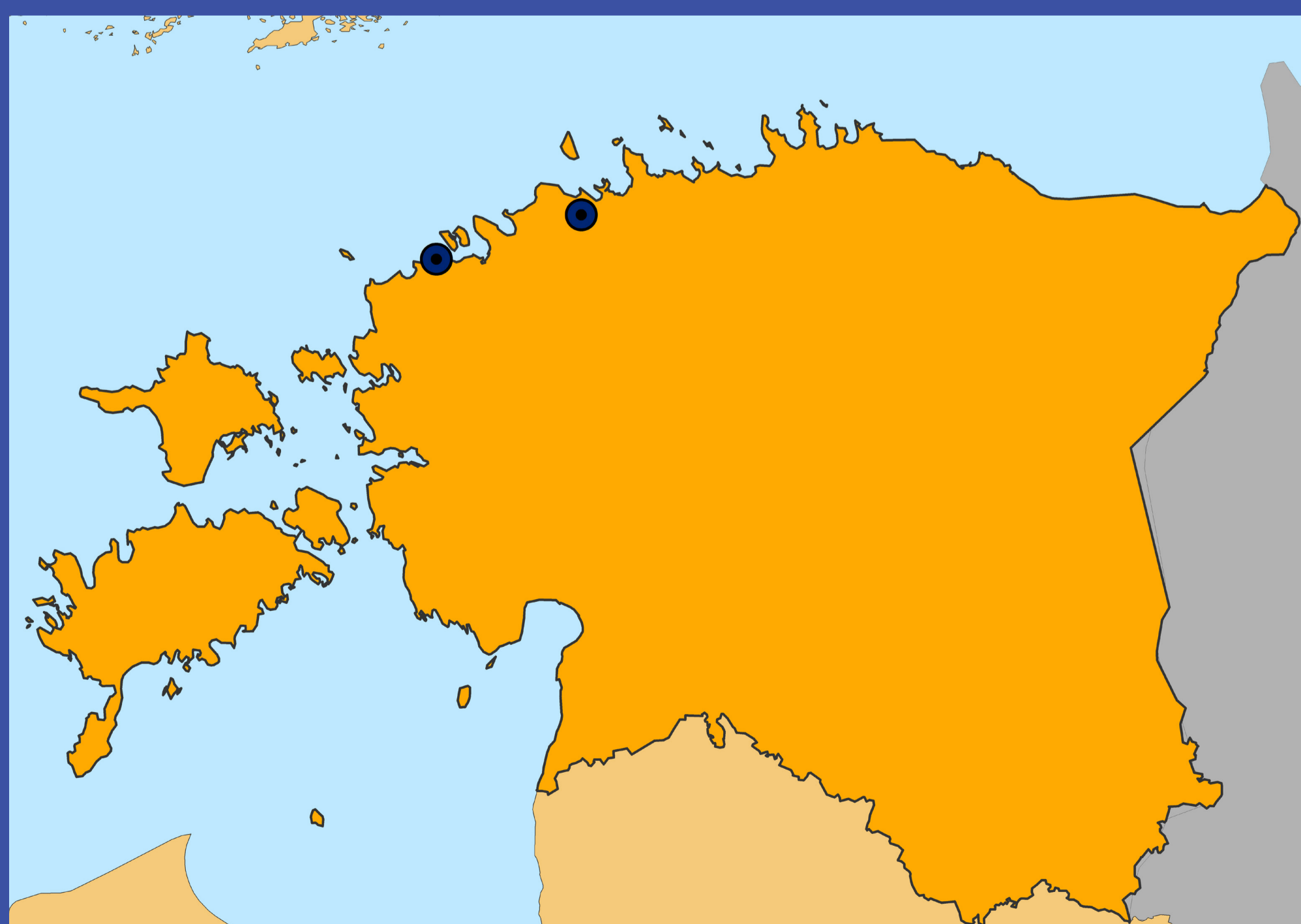

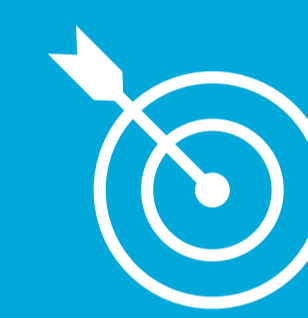

- Turnover in 2014 more than EUR 17.5 million
- 195 employees in 2014
- Plant capacity increased by around 30% to 4,000 tonnes of goods produced per year
